
## **Setting Up Your Phone Adapter**

(with a Router or Router Enabled Modem\*)

- 1. Connnect the AC Adapter to the back of the Talk & Save Home Phone Adapter in the port labeled "DC 5V Power". Connect the AC Adapter to a nearby power outlet.
- 2. Connect the Ethernet cable to the port labeled "Internet".
- 3. Connect your existing phone cable from your telephone into the Talk & Save Home Phone Adapter port labeled "Phone 1".

Your Talk & Save Home Phone Adapter will activate and automatically configure itself to the appropriate settings based on your phone number, plan and features. Please wait up to 15 minutes for the initial configuration to complete.

\* You will generally be able to tell if your modem also serves as a router if there are multiple "LAN" ports on the back, typically labelled 1-4.



### Setting Up Your Phone Adapter (without a Router)

- 1. Unplug your modem from any devices which it is currently connected to. Unplug your modem from the power outlet.
- 2. Connect the AC Adapter to the back of the Talk & Save Home Phone Adapter in the port labeled "DC 5V Power". Connect the AC Adapter to a nearby power outlet.
- 3. Unplug the existing Ethernet cable from your computer and connect it to the port labeled "Internet" on the Talk & Save Home Phone Adapter.
- 4. Connect the Ethernet cable to the port labeled "Ethernet" on the Talk & Save Home Phone Adapter and connect the other end to the Ethernet port on your computer.
- 5. Connect your existing phone cable from your telephone to the Talk & Save Home Phone Adapter port labeled "Phone 1"
- 6. Plug your modem into a nearby power outlet.

Your Talk & Save Home Phone Adapter will activate and automatically configure itself to the appropriate settings based on your phone number, plan and features. Please wait up to 15 minutes for the initial configuration to complete.
